

Museum Barberini – Permission to Take Photographs or Film in the Museum

Permission must be granted by the Museum Barberini before taking photographs or filming for professional purposes and/or for publication.

Please observe the following precautionary measures:

1. Please discuss and agree upon the location of your shots beforehand with the Museum Barberini's press department.
2. Lighting gear must be equipped with protective covers.
3. The distance between light stands and objects on display must be at least 2.5 meters and may not be less than the height of the stand including the lamp.
4. Lights may only be on during the time it takes to measure the exposure and shoot the scene. Lights must be turned off during breaks in shooting, set-up, and movement.
5. Only indirect, diffuse lighting is allowed in galleries with works on paper.
6. Please do not touch the artwork.
7. We kindly request that you abide by our safety rules and follow the instructions of our staff.
